## Balance of Trade

The deficit in the balance of formal trade in goods was US\$ 328.84 million in May 2023, an increase of 28.16 per cent compared to the previous month of April. Year-over-year, the formal trade in goods deficit increased by 8.17 per cent on the deficit of May 2022.

## Exports

In May 2023 domestic exports value increased by 5.95 per cent compared to April 2023 and by 42.88 per cent compared to May 2022. Table 2 shows exported goods in value of exports in May 2023 by SITC sections.

In May 2023, total imports values increased by 22.63 per cent compared to April 2023 and by 18.30 per cent compared to May 2022.
