





Participation Rate Trend













Composition by Gender



Distribution by education




Distribution by educational attainment






Employed population by sector of employment


Average hourly cash income from employment of employees at main job by broad branch of economic activity (RWF per hour)



Unemployment rate by sex




Unemployment rate by sex




Unemployment rate by age group




Unemployment rate by education attainment


