## Balance of Trade

The deficit in the balance of formal trade in goods was US\$ 106.87 million in May 2016, a decrease of 14.18 percent compared to the previous month of April 2016. Year-over-year, the formal trade in goods deficit increased by 2.43 percent on the deficit of May 2015.

## Exports

In May 2016, domestic exports values increased by 16.23 \% compared to April 2016 and by $8.10 \%$ compared to May 2015. Table 2 shows the ten most exported goods in value of exports.
