## Balance of Trade

The deficit in the balance of formal trade in goods was US\$ 82.96 million in July 2016, a decrease of 23.37 per cent compared to the previous month of June 2016. Year-over-year, the formal trade in goods deficit decreased by 11.62 per cent on the deficit of July 2015.

## Exports

In July 2016, domestic exports values increased by 11.11 \% compared to June 2016 and decreased by $26.75 \%$ compared to July 2015. Table 2 shows the ten most exported goods in value of exports.

In July 2016, re-exports values decreased by 26.55 per cent compared to June 2016 and decreased by 10.04 per cent compared to June 2015.
