## Balance of Trade

The deficit in the balance of formal trade in goods was US\$ 141.71 million in May 2018, an increase of 10.94 per cent compared to the previous month of April 2018. Year-over-year, the formal trade in goods deficit decreased by 13.57 per cent on the deficit of May 2017.

## Exports

In May 2018, domestic exports values decreased by 4.82 per cent compared to April 2018 and increased by 28.51 per cent compared to May 2017. Table 2 shows exported goods in value of exports in May 2018 by SITC sections.

## Imports

In May 2018, total imports values increased by 7.36 per cent compared to April 2018 but decreased by 3.10 per cent compared to May 2017. Table 3 shows imported goods in value of imports in May 2018 by SITC sections.

## Re-exports
