


In Q1 2019,GDP at current prices was estimated to be 2,144 Billion Frw, up from 1,987 in Q1 2018. Estimates calculated in 2014 prices show that GDP growth was 8.4% which is higher in real terms compared to Q1 2018

Expenditure on GDP

In 2019 Q1,Final consumption expenditure of Household and Government contributed respectively 77 % and 16% of total GDP.

In 2019 Q1, Gross capital formation contributed 25 % to the total GDP, and grew by 12 % in real terms.

In 2019 Q1, Exports of goods and services Increased by 5 % in real terms.

In 2019 Q1, Imports grew by 11 % in real terms ,mainly boosted by import of construction materials and petroleum products.


1. Gross Domestic Product and its structure

In the First quarter of 2019, GDP at current market prices was estimated to be Frw 2,144 billion, up from Frw 1,987 billion in Q1 2018. In this quarter, services sector contributed 48 percent of GDP while agriculture sector contributed 28 percent of the GDP. Industry sector contributed 17 percent of the GDP and 7 percent was attributed to adjustment for taxes and subsidies on products.

2. Growth rate by kind of activity

In the first quarter of 2019, estimates calculated in 2014 prices show that GDP was 8.4 percent higher compared to the first quarter of 2018.

2.1. Agriculture



In this quarter, agriculture sector grew by 4 percent and contributed 1.2 percentage points to the overall GDP growth rate. The growth in agriculture is attributed to food crops which grew by 4 percent and livestock which grew by 14 percent, while export crops production decreased by 9 percent.

The growth of food crops is attributed to harvest of Season A of 2019 while the decrease in export crops is due to a decrease of 7% in production of tea and a decrease of 19% in production of other cash crops (incl. flowers, pyrethrum & sugar cane), however coffee increased by 2%.

2.2. Industry

The industry sector grew by 18 percent and contributed 2.9 percentage points to overall GDP growth. The growth in industry sector was mainly attributed to growth of 30 percent and 8 percent in construction and manufacturing activities respectively. Mining & quarrying activities increased by 12% boosted by quarrying activities which increased by 20%.

Within manufacturing, Beverages and Tobacco increased by 9 percent, Wood & paper; printing by 38%, Textiles clothes and leather goods by 15 percent. In addition production of construction materials such as non-metallic mineral products increased by 21 percent and metallic products by 11%.


2.3. Services

The service sector grew by 8 percent and contributed 3.7 percentage points to overall GDP growth.

The growth in Service sector was due to growth of several activities. Within this sector, wholesale and retail trade increased by 7 percent due to an increase in tradable manufactured products; transport activities increased by 11 percent boosted by air transport that increased by 21 percent, financial services increased by 14 percent and Professional scientific and technical activities by 25%.

3. Expenditure GDP

In Q1 of 2019, total final consumption expenditure increased by 9 percent, with household final expenditures increasing by 7 percent. Exports increased by 5 percent and imports by 11 percent while Gross capital formation increased by 12 percent.
