



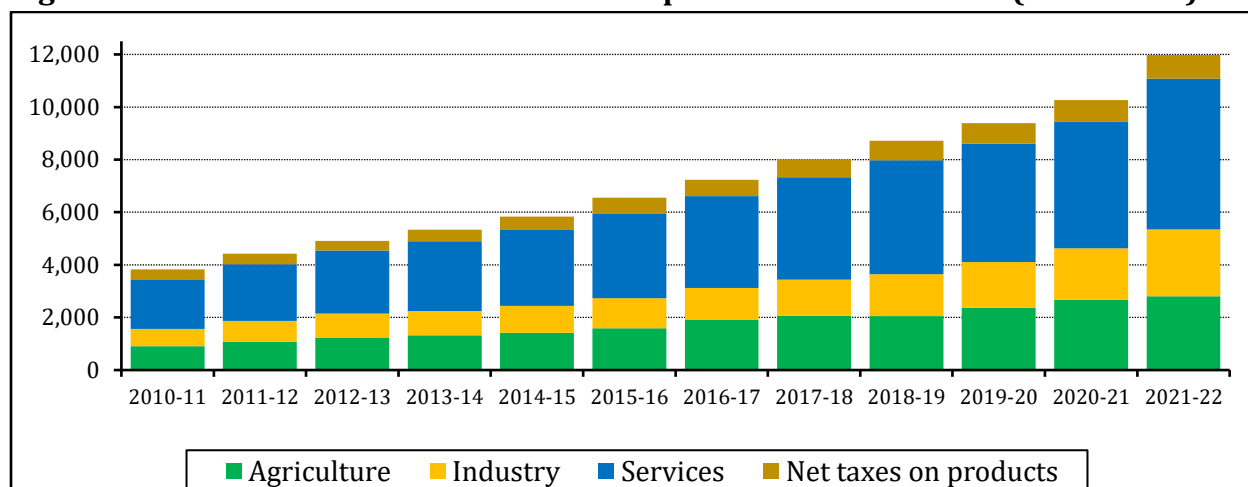

Gross Domestic Product (GDP): 2021-22

1. Gross Domestic Product and its structure

In the fiscal year 2021-22, GDP at current market prices was estimated at Frw 11,976 billion, up from Frw 10,266 billion in 2020-21.

Figure 1: Gross Domestic Product in current prices and its structure (billion Frw)

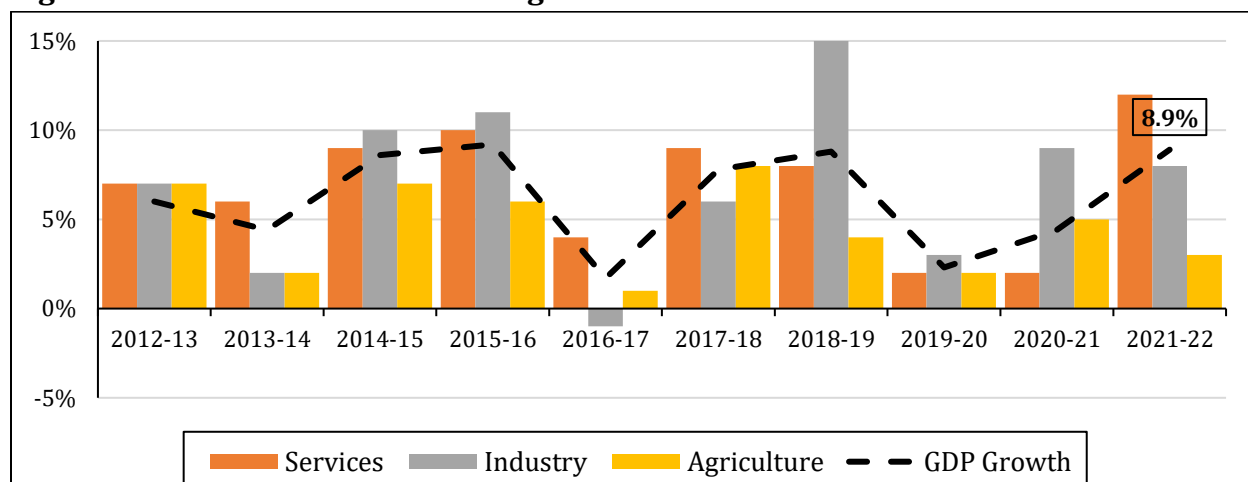


Services sector contributed 48 percent of GDP, agriculture sector contributed 23 percent of GDP, Industry sector contributed 21 percent of GDP, while 8 percent was attributed to adjustment for taxes and subsidies on products.

2. Growth rate by kind of activity

In 2021-22, estimates calculated in 2017 prices show that GDP was 8.9 percent higher in real terms when compared to 2020-21.

2.1. Agriculture sector

Agriculture sector increased by 3 percent and contributed 0.8 percentage points to the overall GDP growth rate. Within agriculture, food crops increased by 2 percent, livestock increased by 9 percent while export crops decreased by 1 percent.

2.2. Industry sector

Industry sector increased by 8 percent and contributed 1.6 percentage points to overall GDP growth rate. Within industry, mining & quarrying increased by 15 percent, Manufacturing activities increased by 8 percent while construction activities increased by 6 percent,

Within manufacturing, food processing grew by 6 percent, Chemicals, rubber & plastic activities grew by 14 percent, textiles, clothing & leather goods grew by 17 percent, wood & paper; printing increased by 14 percent, furniture & other manufacturing by 3 percent while non-metallic mineral products by 24 percent. However, the production of metal products, machinery & equipment decreased by 7 percent.

2.3. Service sector

Services sector increased by 12 percent and contributed 5.8 percentage points to overall GDP growth. In this sector, wholesale & retail trade increased by 11 percent, transport services increased by 21 percent, hotels and restaurants increased by 98 percent, financial services grew by 16 percent, professional, scientific & technical services grew by 7 percent, while information & Communication grew by 13 percent.

Public administration activities increased by 3 percent, human health and social work activities increased by 13 percent and while and education services increased by 32 percent.

3. Expenditure GDP

In 2021-22, total final consumption expenditure increased by 8 percent mainly due to an increase of 15 percent in government final expenditure and 7 percent in household final expenditure. Exports of goods and services increased by 15 percent while imports of goods and services increased by 13 percent.
