# Monthly Statistics of External Trade in Goods of July 2023

#### **Balance of Trade**

The deficit in the balance of formal trade in goods was US\$ 315.37 million in July 2023, an increase of 9.23 per cent compared to the previous month of June. Year-over-year, the formal trade in goods deficit increased by 1.92 per cent on the deficit of July 2022.

#### **Exports**

In July 2023 domestic exports value decreased by 34.43 per cent compared to June 2023 but increased by 19.41 per cent compared to July 2022. Table 2 shows the values of exported goods in July 2023 by SITC sections.
