## June 2016

## Balance of Trade

The deficit in the balance of formal trade in goods was US\$ 108.27 million in June 2016, an increase of 1.31 per cent compared to the previous month of May 2016. Year-over-year, the formal trade in goods deficit increased by 22.36 per cent on the deficit of June 2015.

## Exports

In June 2016, domestic exports values increased by 4.91 \% compared to May 2016 and $12.20 \%$ compared to June 2015. Table 2 shows the ten most exported goods in value of exports.

In June 2016, total imports values decreased by 0.16 per cent compared to May 2016 and also decreased by 13.18 per cent compared to June 2015.

In June 2016, re-exports values decreased by 15.23 per cent compared to May 2016 and increased by 23.32 per cent compared to June 2015.
