Gross Domestic Product – 2017 Q4

I. Gross Domestic Product (GDP) and its structure

In the fourth quarter of 2017, GDP at current market prices was estimated to be Frw 1,985 billion, up from Frw 1,751 billion in Q4 2016. In Q4 2017, services sector contributed 46 percent of GDP while agriculture sector contributed 31 percent of the GDP. Industry sector contributed 16 percent of the GDP and 7 percent was attributed to adjustment for taxes and subsidies on products.

II. Growth rate by kind of activity

In 2017 Q4, estimates calculated in 2014 prices show that GDP growth was 10.5 percent higher in real terms compared to the same quarter of 2016.

In this quarter, agriculture increased by 10 percent and contributed 2.7 percentage points to the overall GDP growth rate. Food crops increased by 11 percent due to good harvest of Season B and C of 2017 compared to the low growth of 1 percent realised in same seasons of 2016.

Activities in the industry sector increased by 10 percent and contributed 1.7 percentage points to GDP growth rate with Mining and Quarrying growing at 51% and contributing to the overall GDP growth rate by 1.2 percentage points. Manufacturing activities increased by 7 percent boosted mainly by an increase of 16 percent in food processing activities, 19 percent in textile, clothing & leather and 14 percent in manufacturing of chemicals, rubber & plastic products. Construction activities decreased by 1 percent.

Activities in service sector increased by 11 percent in Q4 2017. Given their weight and growth the following are the main contributors: administrative & support services by 37 percent, Transport services by 16 percent and information & communication by 13 percent. Wholesale and retail trade activities has recovered and increase by 19 percent due to an increase of traded agricultural, manufactured and imported products.

The adjustment for taxes and subsidies increased by 9 percent.

III. Expenditure GDP

In Q4 of 2017, total final consumption expenditure increased by 1 percent. Government final expenditures increased by 10 percent while household final expenditures decreased by 1 percent. Exports increased by 58 percent while imports increased by 20 percent. Gross capital formation increased by 27 percent mainly due to imports of capital goods.
