# Monthly Statistics of External Trade in Goods June 2019

#### **Balance of Trade**

The deficit in the balance of formal trade in goods was US\$ 167.65 million in June 2019, a decrease of 14.65 percent compared to the previous month of May. Year-over-year, the formal trade in goods deficit increased by 13.98 percent on the deficit of June 2018.

In June 2019, domestic exports value has increased by 39.97 percent compared to May 2019 and decreased by 13.46 percent compared to June 2018. Table 2 shows exported goods in value of exports in June 2019 by SITC sections.
