Balance of Trade

The deficit in the balance of formal trade in goods was US\$ 181.11million in August2019, a decrease of 0.61percent compared to the previous month of July. Year-over-year, the formal trade in goods deficit increased by 10.12 percent on the deficit of August 2018.
