## Balance of Trade

The deficit in the balance of formal trade in goods was US\$ 132.02 million in May 2020, an increase of 2.66 per cent compared to the previous month of April. Year-over-year, the formal trade in goods deficit decreased by 42.66 per cent compared to May 2019.

## Exports

In May 2020, domestic exports values increased by 26.76 per cent compared to April 2020 and by 17.73 per cent compared to May 2019. Table 2 shows exported goods in value of exports in May 2020 by SITC sections.
