Monthly Statistics of External Trade in Goods July 2021

Balance of Trade

The deficit in the balance of formal trade in goods was US\$ 226.36 million in July 2021, an increase of 18.28 per cent compared to the previous month of June. Year-over-year, the formal trade in goods deficit increased by 82.72 per cent on the deficit of July 2020.

Exports

In July 2021, domestic exports values decreased by 22.05 per cent compared to June 2021 and by 35.06 per cent compared to July 2020. Table 2 shows exported goods in value of exports in July 2021 by SITC sections.
