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#### Monthly Statistics of External Trade in Goods July 2022

#### **Balance of Trade**

The deficit in the balance of formal trade in goods was US\$ 303.45 million in July 2022, an increase of 1.16 per cent compared to the previous month of June 2022. Year-over-year, the formal trade in goods deficit increased by 32.92 per cent on the deficit of July 2021.

#### **Exports**

In July 2022 domestic exports values decreased by 11.92 per cent compared to June 2022 and increased by 39.10 per cent compared to July 2021. Table 2 shows exported goods in value of exports in July 2022 by SITC sections.
