Balance of Trade

The deficit in the balance of formal trade in goods was US\$ 215.35 million in November 2020, an increase of 28.58 per cent compared to the previous month of October. Year-over-year, the formal trade in goods deficit increased by 24.29 per cent on the deficit of November 2019.
