Students who were part of the top 3 teams at any previous competition are not allowed to enter the infographics competition but may still enter the hackathon.

Each group is allowed to participate in both competitions



By entering the competition, the entrants agree to grant permission to NISR to use and reproduce their work with an appropriate acknowledgement.



Submissions for the infographic competition will be expected in either PDF, AI, EPS, SVG, or image format. Only one static with it's corresponding dynamic infographic are allowed
